Expedition

The report includes the goals and reflections. So all together or every participant on his own is going to create a report. They could write one but it is also allowed to create a film or a PowerPoint presentation or use another creative way of telling the story.

These are the topics to be covered:

- who was part of the group?
- how did you do your AJ: walking, canoeing, on a horse?
- in which area did you do your AJ?
- What was your goal or research topic during the AJ?
- how did you work to get results?
- what are the results of your research?
- can you tell something about some special moment during the AJ?
- write a short reflection about your own part and role in the group: what went well and not so well and what did you learn? What would you do different next time?

Exploration

The report includes investigation on a specific subject. An exploration must involve pre-journey reflections on the chosen topic.
